

Family-Friendly Campground Rules

Welcome to our campground! To keep this a safe and enjoyable place for all families, please follow these simple rules:

General Courtesy

- Be respectful of your fellow campers at all times.
- Quiet hours are from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Please keep voices, music, and activity at a low volume during these hours. No generators allowed in the campground.
- Children must be supervised by an adult.

Campsite Care

- One family/party per designated campsite, maximum of 4 people per site.
- Keep your campsite clean—dispose of trash in provided bins.
- Fires are only allowed in fire pits, no ground fires. Never leave a fire unattended, and fully extinguish before leaving.
- Protect nature—do not damage trees, plants, or wildlife.

Safety

- Speed limit within campground: **5 MPH**. Drive carefully and watch for children.
- After unloading your vehicle, please park in the designated lot adjacent to the campground.
- Firearms, fireworks, and illegal substances are strictly prohibited.
- Please keep your pets at home.

Facilities

- Restrooms and showers are shared spaces—keep them tidy for the next person.
- Dishwashing is only allowed in designated areas (not in restrooms).

- Water spigots are for filling containers only; please do not wash at them.
- Dumping of water is not permitted.

Activities

- Be considerate when playing music or games—family fun is encouraged, but respect your neighbors.
- Festival closes at sundown, no wandering outside of the campground is allowed after the faire closes.

Departure

- Check-out time: **11:00 AM** Monday morning unless otherwise arranged.
- Please leave your campsite in as good or better condition than you found it.
- There is a dumpster near the exit gate for you to dispose of trash.
